In February 1788 a group of 10 men certified a house in Hartwell occupied by Mary Hinds as a place of worship for Protestant dissenters. This was evidently the beginning of the Methodist cause in Hartwell. Also in 1798 another house in Hartwell was certified by Elizabeth Travell (the occupier) and seven others, and in 1813 a dwelling house in the occupation of Isaac Robbins was certified.
